Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 17.06.2016 and that the trial is still nowhere near conclusion, with only one witness out of twenty having been examined so far but that witness being the complainant himself.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surinder Singh, does not dispute the factual position as above.

On specific query, she submits again on instructions, that there is no other case registered against the petitioner.

In view of the above, since the trial is likely to continue for some time, and the material witness has been examined, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court, subject to his

continuing to appear before that Court as and when summoned, and
complying with all other conditions as would be laid down by that Court.
