Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.128 dated 12.06.2017 registered under Sections 341, 324, 323 and 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 326 IPC added lateron), at Police Station Sadar, District Patiala.

Learned counsel inter-alia contends that the charge is yet to be framed. The petitioner is in custody since last more than two months. Nothing has to be recovered from the petitioner. The conclusion of the trial shall take sufficient long time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner any further in jail.

Considering over all facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and

the petitioner is granted regular bail, during the trial, subject to his furnishing bail/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
