Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was initially granted bail by the learned trial Court but he could not come present on one date, leading to cancellation of his bail bonds.

In view of the fact that the petitioner did not appear before the trial Court when summoned, no case for anticipatory bail is made out. Hence, this petition is dismissed.

However, upon the petitioner surrendering before the learned trial Court and presenting an application for regular bail, it would be disposed of on the same day by that Court, on its own merits, since the contention is that he absented on only a single date.
