The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 69 dated 27.06.2017, registered under Sections 15, 61 and 85 of NDPS Act, at Police Station Moga Sadar, District Moga.

The allegation against the petitioners are that they were carrying two plastic bags containing poppy husk and both the bags weighed 27 Kg. The petitioners are in custody since 27.06.2017 and since then they are in jail.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned with the following conditions:-

1. Petitioners shall file an undertaking before the trial Court that they will not indulge in similar or any other kind of offence in future;
2. Petitioners shall deposit their passport with the trial Court;

- 3. Petitioners shall report to the police station concerned on Monday, Wednesday and Sunday ever week between 11:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.;
- 4. In default of these conditions, the trial Court shall be at liberty to take the petitioners in custody;
- 5. Petitioners shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
