Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.520 dated 13.09.2017 under Sections 323, 325, 506, 147, 148 of IPC and Section 3 of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station City Palwal, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 09.10.2017 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surinder Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 09.10.2017 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
