Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.125 dated 07.09.2016 registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC, at Police Station Hoshiarpur.

In the FIR, allegations were made by complainant-Bhanu Gupta against the husband of the petitioner that he allured the complainant for sending him to Australia. The deal was struck for a sum of Rs.6,10,000/- and an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- was paid in the year 2013. An amount of Rs.4,00,000/- was paid in the house of main accused and the petitioner which was allegedly handed over to the petitioner. The balance amount of Rs.1,00,000/- was also paid to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the brother-in-law of the petitioner i.e. Kuldeep Singh issued three cheques in a sum of Rs.2,00,000/- each on 05.06.2016 for satisfying the outstanding amount towards his brother and the present petitioner, but those cheques were ultimately dishonoured. Said Kuldeep Singh has already been granted regular bail by the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions from the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to pay an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- by way of demand draft in the name of the complainant within two weeks from today before the Investigating Officer.

In view of above, I deem it appropriate to allow the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner on depositing a demand draft in a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- in the name of the complainant on or before 24.03.2017.

In case the aforesaid undertaking is not honoured, this order will be of no consequence.

Disposed of accordingly.
