Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) to look into the representation of the petitioner dated 18.09.2017 (Annexure P-1) as the private respondents in connivance with the police official are harassing the petitioner and his family member and wants to implicate them in some false case. Prayer has also been made to protect the life and property of the petitioner's family at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that wife of petitioner is working as Anganwari Worker at village Saidoke. Private respondents are harassing and threatening to get her dismissed from the service. They are seeking information qua her record under Right to

Information Act time and again.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for petitioner has confined his prayer qua protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members. He states that for the said relief petitioner has already submitted a complaint/representation dated 18.09.2017 (Annexure P-1) and the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family member.

Notice of motion only to respondents No.1 and 2 at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. M.S. Nagra, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without making any observation on the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) to look into the threat perception, if any, to the petitioner and his family member and to act in accordance with law.
