Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.47 dated 10.06.2017 under Sections 307, 323, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, Distirct Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. Main injury i.e. fire arm injury has been attributed to Manjit Singh and Buta Singh and even the main accused Manjit Singh has been released on regular bail by learned trial Judge on 03.10.2017. More so, the petitioner is in custody since 25.06.2017 and decision of the case still to take some more time. So he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel affirmed the fact that the main injuries are attributed to Manjit Singha and Buta Singh and the present petitioner has not been caused any injury to the complainant.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the main injury i.e. fire arm injury has been attributed to Manjit Singh and Buta Singh and the fact that the main accused Manjit Singh has been released on regular bail by learned trial Judge on 03.10.2017. More so, the petitioner is in custody since 25.06.2017; decision of the case still to take some more time; and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in custody, he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Area Magistrate.

The petition stands allowed.
