On 19.01.2017, following order was passed by this
Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that during course of investigation in FIR No.190 dated 11.12.2015, statements of witnesses were recorded. Names of Jaswinder Singh and Jaspal Singh appeared at serial Nos.60 and 70 respectively. Jaswinder Singh and Jaspal Singh are husbands of Darshna Devi and Harpreet Kaur respectively. It is not in dispute that statements of aforesaid witnesses are the same in both the cases. Petitioner was arrested in FIR No.190 dated 11.12.2015 on 17.12.2015 and was granted regular bail by this Court (Annexure P6).

Adjourned to 16.03.2017.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 23.01.2017 and in the event of his appearance, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that pursuant to the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sushil Kumar admitted the aforesaid fact and stated that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of above, interim order dated 19.01.2017 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
