INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.405 dated 07.11.2015 under Sections 302, 307, 323, 34 IPC and Sections 25, 27 and 30 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Hansi, District Hisar.

Notice of motion.

Mr.B.S.Virk, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested the petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that out of 28 witnesses, 22 witnesses have been examined. As per the prosecution version, the present petitioner was stated to be armed with pistol and fired on complainant-Joginder, but it

by the present petitioner in the commission of the offence.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, nature and gravity of the offence and in view of role played by the petitioner, I do not find it a fit case where petitioner is entitled to benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.

However, as the petitioner is stated to have been in custody since 07.11.2015, therefore, the trial Court is directed to decide the case expeditiously, preferably within three months, by giving short adjournments or even by adjourning the case on day to day basis, if necessary. The Investigating Officer/SHO concerned is directed to produce the witnesses before the trial Court on the next two-three dates. The Senior Superintendent of Police, Hisar is directed to supervise and personally look into the matter for producing the witnesses before the trial Court on the next two-three dates.
