INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners-Gurmit Singh and Jasbir Singh have filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.41 dated 09.05.2017, registered at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, Punjab, under Sections 308, 325, 324, 323 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, petitioner No.1-Gurmit Singh has been stated to be armed with *gandasi*,

but no injury has been attributed to him. Petitioner No.2-Jasbir Singh has been stated to be armed with *datar* and simple injury under Section 324 IPC on the person of Makhan Singh has been attributed to him.

The petitioners have been in custody since 21.07.2017. They are not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as they are in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioners in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
