ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.25 dated 06.02.2017 under Section 408 IPC registered at Police Station Division No.8, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner, who is a truck driver, are that when he was employed with the complainant, he along with co-accused, instead of returning the truck to complainant, had misappropriated it and allegedly sold it to some other person. He further states that petitioner is in custody for almost two months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, states that investigation has been completed and challan was filed on 10.10.2017. He has also filed custody certificate which indicates that the petitioner is in custody for 01

month and 26 days ever since the date of his arrest on 14.08.2017.

The petitioner is a truck driver who is accused of not returning the truck and instead selling it and misappropriating the money. He is in custody for almost 02 months. The investigation has been completed and challan has been filed.

In view of the aforementioned facts and circumstances, I deem it an appropriate case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner Shamsheer Singh @ Shera is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
