The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner, namely Surjit Singh @ Seeti, under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure to seek regular bail in case F.I.R. No. 27, dated 06.04.2017, registered under Sections 15/18/21/22/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Bilga, Tehsil Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

2. Perused Case Diary, including the Recovery Memo maintained therein, which was sought for in the last order.

3. It is further ascertained that the petitioner was apprehended on the basis of information provided by some “social worker”, which in

essence is information conveyed by some secret source.

4. Considering the recovery effected from the petitioner and his involvement, as emerging from the list maintained in the Case Diary, in other cases under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, this Court is not inclined to grant him the benefit of regular bail at this stage.

5. Dismissed.
