The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioners in case FIR No.0088 dated 17th June, 2017, registered under Sections 147, 148, 323, 324, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, (for short, 'the IPC') (later on Sections 326 and 307 of the IPC were added) at Police Station Ding, District Sirsa.

The grievous injury allegedly suffered by the victim is not attributable to the petitioners directly.

Considering the long detention undergone by the present petitioners, namely Sandeep Singh, Baljinder Singh and Gurpreet
