The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case F.I.R. No. 400, dated 23.06.2017, registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 341 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 326 of the Indian Penal Code was added later on, at Police Station Hansi City, District Hisar.

2. The petitioner was arrested in connection with F.I.R. No. 400 on 11.08.2017. Section 326 of the Indian Penal Code was subsequently added.

3. Co-accused Om Parkash has already been granted bail earlier

by this Court.

4. The role imputed to the petitioner in causing injury to the victim is qualitatively different from that of accused Sonu and Monu.

5. In the given circumstances, there is no justification to confine the petitioner in detention for an indefinite period.

6. In view of above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely Anil @ Tinu son of Ramesh, is directed to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.
