Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been made for quashing of F.I.R. No.80 dated 12.06.2013 under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code pertaining to Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar, on the basis of compromise dated 05.01.2016 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the Magistrate to furnish report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, report of the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sri Anandpur Sahib vide covering letter No.249 dated 27.10.2016 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions, Rupnagar vide Endst. No.12705 dated 28.10.2016 has been received.

According to the report of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sri Anandpur Sahib, the compromise between the parties is voluntarily, genuine and without any undue influence, pressure or coercion.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, F.I.R. No.80 dated 12.06.2013 under Section 420 I.P.C pertaining to Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
