By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought multiple prayers, but learned counsel for the petitioner states that he restricts his prayer qua expeditious investigation of the FIR No.52 dated 19.05.2017 under Sections 302/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Kot Isah Khan, District Moga (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though the FIR in question was registered on 19.05.2017, but investigation in the case is going slowly. For speedy investigation, the petitioner has already made a representation dated 17.08.2017 (Annexure P-3) to the respondent No.2 i.e. Deputy Inspector General, Bathinda and at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to consider the said representation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5 only.

On asking of this Court, Mr. M.S. Nagra, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case and considering the restricted prayer of the petitioner seeking expeditious investigation of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-3) for expeditious investigation of the case.
