The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0071 dated 17.08.2016 for the offence under Sections 376 IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act., registered at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur, Punjab (Section 363, 366-A, 506, 120-B added at the time of framing of charges on 13.01.2017).

Petitioner is in custody from 18.08.2016.

Learned counsel for the State submits that out of 20 prosecution witnesses, three witnesses have been examined and complainant has also been examined.

Keeping in view the above and considering the fact that trial is not likely to mature in near future, petitioner be released on regular bail on furnishing his fresh bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, Sangrur.
