KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The State has filed the reply/status report by way of affidavit of Sanjeev Balhara, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur Jhirka on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 in the Court today and the same is taken on record. In the reply, it is stated that petitioner No.2 is previously married to one Julekha and has two daughters from his first marriage with Julekha. However, during inquiry, Julekha stated that she has no objection to the second marriage of her husband. It is also stated that an FIR No.565, dated 03.10.2017, under Sections 363 and 366 IPC and Section 3(2)(v) of SC/ST, Act at Police Station Nandbai is registered against petitioner No.2 and one Arif for kidnapping petitioner No.1.

In these circumstances, the police may continue with
the investigation in the said FIR and may take any necessary action as

permissible under the law. However, at the same time, the State is also directed to ensure that the private respondents do not cause any physical harm to the petitioners.

As such, the present petition is disposed of.
