The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.77 dated 25.05.2017 registered under Sections 171, 307, 420, 467, 468 & 471 IPC and 25/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Ding, District Sirsa.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

This Court did not grant regular bail to the petitioner since the complainant/victim was not examined before the trial Court and therefore this Court directed the trial Court to examine the complainant vide order dated 01.11.2017. Now counsel for the petitioner has produced before me a copy of deposition of the complainant/victim. The complainant in his statement said that he does not know anything about

the present case and consequently he has been declared hostile. In other words, he does not support the prosecution case.

In that view of the matter, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-37743 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
