ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.106 dated 19.09.2016 under Sections 452/324/323/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Passiana, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that allegations against the petitioners are that they had tried to take forcible possession of the land, whereon houses of the complainant and others were constructed. He further contends that as per demarcation report annexed as Annexure P-3, the house of complainant has been illegally constructed at Khasra No.368. She also contends that there is no allegation against the petitioners of having caused any injuries and even otherwise, the allegations against other accused are only of causing simple injuries. She

further contends that a cross DDR has also been registered at the behest of petitioner party as some of them have also received injuries in the incident.

This Court, by the order dated 09.10.2017, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Pawan Kumar, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 09.10.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
