Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.94 dated 11.10.2016, under Sections 302, 323, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur.

Petitioner was arrested on 11.10.2016 and is in jail since then. Now the deposition of the witnesses have been recorded before the trial Court. I have perused the deposition of PW1-Ghamdoor Singh-star witness of the prosecution. I have also perused the order granting regular bail to Sarabjit Kaur. Perusal of the statement of PW1 shows that the petitioner had pelted brick-bats towards Narayan Singh which hit him on his forehead. Similar is the role attributed to Sarabjit Kaur. Petitioner being a woman and material witness having been examined, there is no chance now of tampering with the evidence/witnesses.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner shall be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall file undertaking before the trial Court that she will not indulge in similar or any other kind of offence in future. Petitioner shall deposit her passport with the trial Court. Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
