By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.92 dated 14.09.2011, registered under Section 382 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Division No.4, Ludhiana.

On 17.11.2016, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court on 8.8.2016 for the reason that on 4.7.2016, he met with an accident and got fracture of ribs of left shoulder bone and other injuries. However, on 31.8.2016, his father had expired and in these circumstances, he could not appear before the trial Court though he sought exemption from appearance. He further states that now the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court.

Notice of motion for 13.1.2017.

Meanwhile, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within one week from today, he shall be admitted on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 17.11.2016, the petitioner has furnished bail bonds and surety bonds before the trial

Court. A photocopy of the order dated 22.11.2016 passed by the trial Court is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

The learned State counsel does not controvert the above said fact.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 17.11.2016, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
