Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents i.e. respondents No. 4 to 6.

Interestingly, the petitioners are staying in Ludhiana and are residents of Street No. 31/2, Near Gurudwara Rehru Sahib, Dhillon Nagar, Lohara, District Ludhiana whereas no relief has been claimed against Ludhiana Police.

So far as the prayer of the petitioners to extend protection from the SHO Police Station Kurukshetra is concerned, learned State counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Jagdish Rai HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sahabad (Kurukshetra) alongwith copy of the statement of petitioner No. 1-Jaspinder Kaur wherein she has stated that she and her husband does not require any police protection from Haryana Police because whatever the danger the petitioner apprehends, the same is from

the residents of Patiala.

Since the Punjab Police has not been impleaded in the present petition, the same is dismissed.

However, in case petitioners still apprehend threat to their lives and liberty, they are at liberty to approach Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana.
