Prayer made in the instant petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 not to harass the petitioners at the behest of respondents No.4 to 7.

It is alleged that the petitioners have married against the wishes of parents of petitioner No.1. Photocopies of the Aadhaar Card of both the petitioners, annexed as Annexures P-1 and P-2, show the date of birth of petitioners to be 26.06.1998 and 10.01.1996, respectively.

A perusal of the petition shows that the petitioners have not approached any authority for redressal of their grievance before filing of this petition with the aforesaid allegations.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, by way of filing a representation and in case, the same is filed, respondent No.2 will decide it in accordance with law.

Nothing observed in this order shall mean with regard to the validity of the marriage of the petitioners.

It is also made clear that in case any FIR is registered against petitioner No.2, it will be open for the police authorities to take action in accordance with law.
