Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.29 dated 19.03.2013 registered under Sections 452, 365, 342, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Muktsar, on the basis of compromise dated 03.08.2017 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 09.10.2017 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements with a direction to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to furnish a report qua veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the sub

their statements. Report from the concerned Magistrate has been received vide letter bearing No.228 dated 03.11.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib vide letter No.2726/EB dated 06.11.2017.

According to the report of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Gidderbaha, the compromise between the parties appears to be genuine and valid.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.29, is quashed qua the petitioners.
