Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.77 dated 01.06.2016 registered under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Sadar, Sangrur, District Sangrur, on the basis of compromise dated 14.06.2017 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 10.10.2017 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate for recording their statements with a direction to the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report qua veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sangrur on 25.10.2017 and got recorded their statements. Report from the concerned Magistrate has been received (in

connected case CRM-M-37897-2017) vide letter bearing No.2469 dated

28.10.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Sangur
vide Endorsement No.7082/SB dated 28.10.2017.

According to the report of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate,
Sangur, the compromise effected between the parties seems to be genuine,
without any pressure or undue influence.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and
considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations
between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R.
No.77, is quashed qua the petitioners.
