Learned counsel for the respondent-State, assisted by Mr. Sullar, counsel representing the complainant, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation, but amount of around Rs.20 lakhs has to be recovered from him.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner contends that the dispute in between the parties is of civil nature as the deceased and the petitioner had financial dealings in between them and thus the matter between the parties is of rendition of account.

Considering over all facts and circumstances, since the petitioner has joined investigation, vide order dt.10.10.2017 passed by this Court granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. The demand drafts bearing No.1512236 dated 07.11.2017 of Rs.16,28,603 and No.006224

dated 03.11.2017 of Rs.8,00,000/- totaling Rs.24,28,603/- be given to learned counsel for the complainant against receipt for onward handing over the same to respondent No.2-Pushpa Devi and the same shall be treated as disbursement towards pending dues for M/s P.M. Traders, of which she is proprietor.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
