ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.341 dated 03.11.2015 under Sections 406/420/467/471/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Taraori, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner are that he was a guarantor for the loan obtained by the proprietors of a firm and although the land was no longer in his name, he had furnished guarantee in respect thereof. He further contends that the land had been exchanged by the petitioner with his relatives and the land which was owned by him, has already been attached by the order of DRT. He also contends that petitioner is visually handicapped to the extent of 95% and is also suffering from various ailments including blockage in his arteries, for which he had been operated

upon. He has referred to medical record annexed as Annexure P-1 with the petition in this regard.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, states that investigation has been completed and challan has been presented in the case on 01.09.2017.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that challan has been presented and the conclusion of trial is likely to take some time, I deem it appropriate to grant him the concession of regular bail. Consequently, the petition is allowed. Petitioner Shish Pal is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
