The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.984 dated 23.10.2016 under Section 307/34 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Jind, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he was riding the motorcycle when the main accused, who was on pillion, had fired a shot at the back of injured. He further contends that there is no allegation of the petitioner having actually participated in the occurrence. He is in custody for over 11 months since his arrest on 30.11.2016. The injured has now fully recovered from the injuries.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Narinder Kumar, states that investigation has been completed

and 06 prosecution witnesses including the complainant, out of 19 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is stated to be in custody for over 11 months and the conclusion of trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner Aman is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
