Through these two petitions under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.108 dated 09.11.2011 under Sections 452, 324, 148 and 149 I.P.C. and Cross Case bearing vide D.D.R. No.37 dated 09.11.2011 under Sections 325, 323/34 I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station City-I, Malerkotla, District Sangrur, on

the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 07.02.2017 passed in CRM-M-3803-2017, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court to furnish a report qua veracity of the compromise.

Consequently, the parties appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malerkotla on 29.03.2017 and got recorded their statements for compromise. Reports bearing No.113 and 114 dated 31.03.2017 from the concerned Magistrate duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Sangrur vide Endst. Nos.2084/EB and 2085/EB dated 03.04.2017 have been received.

According to the reports of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malerkotla, the compromise between the parties is voluntary and without pressure.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the petitions are accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.108 as well as Cross Case bearing DDR No.37, qua the petitioners only, are quashed.
