The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.171 dated 11th April, 2017, registered under Section 379-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Seen the order passed by the Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Jhajjar on 17th October, 2017.

It transpires that the only co-accused actually named in the FIR has been granted regular bail after completion of

investigation and submission of charge-sheet. The present petitioner stands on the same footing.
