The instant petition was filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioners on the apprehension that they faced threat to the same at the hands of private respondents as they had entered into matrimony against the wishes of their elders.

Notice of motion was issued in this case on 27.10.2016.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Sohan Lal would apprise the Court that statements of both the petitioners have since been recorded and who have submitted that now they do not apprehend any threat to their life and liberty and that they have staying together as a happily married couple.

In the light of such stand taken on behalf of the State, no further directions are required to be issued in this petition.

Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
