The petitioners are seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 3 for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend threat from respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 23.12.1994 while the petitioner No.2 is stated to be born in the year 1990. The copies of their Aadhaar Cards, in support thereof, are annexed as Annexures P-1 and P-2, respectively.

The petitioners are stated to have solemnized their marriage on 04.10.2017 and the photographs in this regard are annexed as Annexure P-3. It is further stated in the petition that the petitioners had also made a representation dated 04.10.2017 (Annexure P-4) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala and Station House Officer, Police Station Satnampura, District Kapurthala but no action has so far been taken thereon.

Issue notice to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Vermani, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the validity of the marriage and keeping in view the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P and another, JT 2006 (6) SC 173**, the petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala to look into the matter and take appropriate action in accordance with law to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondent(s).
