Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been made for quashing of F.I.R. No.6 dated 30.04.2016 under Sections 380/120-B I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station NRI Phase-7, S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali), on the basis of compromise dated 25.07.2016 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 03.11.2016, the parties were directed to appear before the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Illaqa Magistrate, S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali) on 07.12.2016 to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the Magistrate to furnish report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties appeared before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, S.A.S. Nagar Mohali and got recorded their statements for compromise and report from the concerned Magistrate has also been received vide her covering letter No.364 dated 17.12.2016 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, S.A.S. Nagar vide Endst. No.8493 dated 19.12.2016.

According to the report of Chief Judicial Magistrate, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali, the compromise between the parties is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.6, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
