Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already joined investigation in compliance with the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 27.10.2016 and is ready to face the proceedings without any default and shall remain bound by the conditions provided under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short Cr.P.C.).

Counsel for the State of Haryana, on instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar, conceded to the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner and further states that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, interim bail granted to the petitioner on 27.10.2016 is made absolute subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) He shall join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer.
- (ii) He shall not offer any threat, promise or inducement to

any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing the same to the Investigating Officer/Court; and

(iii) He shall not leave the limits of this country without prior permission of the Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
