This order shall dispose of CRM-M-38166-2017, filed by petitioner-Jugal Kishore and CRM-M-38168-2017, filed by petitioner-Mamta Rani, under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.66 dated

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04.07.2017, registered at Police Station Division No.1, Pathankot, District Pathankot, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in both these petitions. Learned State has counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested these petitions.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been got registered by Dr. Joginder Singh. As per the allegations in the FIR, petitioner-Jugal Kishore got executed the sale deed in his favour by impersonating his wife as his sister.

It has been brought in notice of this Court that sale deed has already been cancelled and sister of petitioner-Jugal Kishore has not got registered the FIR.

In pursuance of the interim orders dated 26.10.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending them to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in these petitions and the same are allowed. The orders 26.10.2017, granting interim

bail to the petitioners, are made absolute. However, the petitioners shall

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join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by
the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
