This order shall dispose of two petitions numbered above being
arisen from the same FIR.

Present petitions under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of
anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Ranjit Singh @ Jeeta and
Lakhwant Singh @ Lakha in FIR No. 107 dated 17.12.2016, under Sections
302/34/323 IPC, registered at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar
Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioner

Ranjit Singh was not named in the FIR and he has been found innocent,

whereas, petitioner Lakhwant Singh was named in the FIR but was found innocent during investigation. Learned counsel for petitioner Lakhwant Singh also contended that even no injury is attributed to him.

Learned Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, in his order on application under Section 193 Cr.P.C., had considered the investigation proceedings as well as the report submitted by the police, thereby declaring Lakhwant Singh and Ranjit Singh to be innocent and ordered to proceed further for trial against these 2 persons as well.

In view of the above that Ranjit Singh was not named in the FIR and has been found innocent during investigation, he is directed to appear before the learned trial Judge and the learned trial Judge shall release him on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

Petitioner Lakhwant Singh shall surrendered before the learned trial Judge and move an appropriate application, which shall be considered by the learned Court below.

Both the petitions stand disposed of.
