Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.99 dated 14.07.2016, under Sections 21(B), 21(C), 22(A), 22(C) and 29 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Ismailabad, Kurukshetra.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery of 1610 tablets of Alprazolam were effected from the petitioner and from a black coloured polythene bag held in his hand.

The same would be construed as commercial quantity.

In view of the bar envisaged under Section 37 of the NDPS Act, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail.

Petition dismissed.
