Petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.76 dated 17.06.2017, under Section 307, 498-A, 406, 323, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Petitioners are the parent-in-laws of the complainant in this case. It is submitted that they have been implicated only because of their relationship. There were temperamental differences of the complainant with her husband. It is submitted that son of the petitioners filed a petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act on 16.05.2017 i.e. before the registration of the present FIR. The complainant had left the matrimonial home in December, 2016. The complainant's husband i.e. petitioners son has been afforded the concession of bail pending trial by this Court on 09.11.2017. The petitioners undertakes to face the proceedings and not abuse the concession of anticipatory bail, if confirmed. The petitioners, it is submitted have joined investigation pursuant to order dated 11.10.2017, passed by this Court. It is thus,

prayed that this petition be allowed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Gurdev Singh, verifies that the petitioners have joined investigation pursuant to order dated 11.10.2017. They are not reported to be involved in any other criminal case.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioners are likely to abscond or that they are likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, but without commenting upon or expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. Consequently, order dated 11.10.2017, is made absolute. Needless to say they shall join investigation as and when required as well as comply with the conditions as stipulated in Section 482 Cr.P.C.
