The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.0134 dated 31st May, 2017, registered under Sections 21-C/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Heard both sides.

Admittedly no recovery was made directly from the petitioner and he has been implicated on the basis of disclosure statement of the co-accused.

It has been mentioned on behalf of the State that the petitioner is involved in a similar case being FIR No.125 of 2017 of Police Station Sadar Dabwali. However, Ld. Counsel for the petitioner draws attention of the Court to the fact that the petitioner has been already granted bail in the said case, in which again no direct recovery was made from him.

Considering the long detention undergone by the present petitioner, namely Raju alias Babu Khan and the fact that the investigation is complete, he may be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
