Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondents No.4 and 5.

Heard.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation (**Annexure P-5**) submitted by the petitioners and to provide requisite security to the petitioners, if the circumstances so require. However, this direction will not validate the marriage said to have taken place between the petitioners and will have no effect on any civil or criminal action which could be initiated in the matter in accordance with law.
