Prayer in this petition is for directing the respondent No.3 to release the petitioners from the custody (Safe House) at Narnaul.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that vide order dated 27.09.2017, a direction was issued to the Superintendent of Police, Narnaul for taking appropriate action on the representation filed by the petitioners regarding protection of their lives and liberty.

Now, the petitioners have filed this petition with a prayer that is virtually contrary to the prayer made in the previous CRM-M-36474 of 2017. However, it is submitted that the protection of lives and liberty of the petitioners is at stake.

However, it is further submitted that the petitioners have been kept in a safe house which amounts to their detention. It is submitted that the petitioners should be released from the custody of respondent No.3.

In support of the submissions made in this petition, the petition is supported by an affidavit of petitioner No.1-Sujata, which is stated to have been attested while in (Safe House) at Narnaul.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Naveen Sheoran, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf

of the respondents-State.

Considering the fact that now the petitioners are not apprehending any threat to their lives and liberty, respondent No.3 -Superintendent of Police, Narnaul, is directed to release them from his custody (Safe House) forthwith.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
