This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the FIR No.65 dated 11.05.2017 registered under Sections 376 and 506 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sadar Shri Muktsar Sahib, District Shri Muktsar Sahib and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel contends that the complainant being major willingly joined the company of the petitioner. Being an employee of the petitioner, the allegation of rape has been levelled only to blackmail the petitioner. Learned counsel refers to various contradictions in the FIR and the statement.

The case is at the initial stage. The contradiction, if any, shall be gone into by the authorities or the competent Court at appropriate stage.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to raise all the pleas with the

authorities or before the competent Court in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
