Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.127 dated 01.08.2017 registered under Section 20 of the N.D.P.S. Act, at Police Station Sadar Dhuri.

According to the prosecution, 500 *Sulfa* was recovered from the petitioner and she is in custody since 01.08.2017.

Considering over all circumstances and the fact that non commercial quantity of contraband has been recovered from the petitioner, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted regular bail, during the trial, subject to her furnishing bail/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
