Prayer in the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.182 dated 13.06.2015 registered under Section 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

During trial, the petitioner absented, therefore, his warrants of arrest were issued.

Learned counsel inter-alia contends that the petitioner did not appear on the date fixed on account of noting down wrong date i.e. 03.07.2017 instead of actual date 09.06.2017.

Since the petitioner has misused the concession of bail, therefore, he does not deserve any anticipatory bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court on or before 23.10.2017 and his application for bail shall be decided by the Court within two days.
