Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.48 dated 05.02.2017 registered under Section 379-B of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar, on the basis of compromise dated 12.09.2017 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 11.10.2017 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements with a direction to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to furnish a report qua veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar on 07.11.2017 and got recorded their statements.

Report from the concerned Judge has been received vide covering letter

According to the report of the District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar, the parties have effected compromise without any undue influence or coercion and the compromise is genuine.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.48, is quashed qua the petitioner.
