The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.603 dated 23.09.2017 under Sections 186/332/353/506/471 IPC registered at Police Station Badshahpur, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that false allegations have been levelled against the petitioner. In fact the petitioner had stopped his car and the police official had hit the bonnet of the car with danda and smashed the wind screen.

Heard.

The allegations against the petitioner in the FIR, which has been registered by Assistant Sub Inspector, are that the petitioner was coming from wrong side of the road and on being signaled to stop by the complainant and other police officials who were on their official duty to control the traffic, he increased the speed of his car and drove it on the wrong side and hit the complainant. The complainant fell on the bonnet of car but the petitioner is stated to have sped up and it is only due to traffic

jam ahead that the vehicle was stopped. It is also alleged that petitioner along with other occupants of the car had given fist blows to the complainant.

In the wake of these serious allegations, I do not deem it appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
