ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.215 dated 17.07.2017 under Sections 399/402/411 IPC, registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he along with other accused had formed a gang which was planning to commit robbery and dacoity. No robbery or dacoity had even been attempted by them. He further contends that co-accused Ajay has been granted regular bail by the trial Court on 24.08.2017. He also contends that petitioner is involved in other cases but the same have been registered after his arrest in the instant case. He further contends that petitioner is in custody for over three months ever since his arrest on 17.07.2017.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Surenderpal Singh, states that investigation has been completed and challan has been presented in the case.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that challan has been presented and the conclusion of trial is likely to take some time, I deem it appropriate to grant him the concession of regular bail. Consequently, the petition is allowed. Petitioner Amritpal Singh @ Bittu is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
