The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking interim bail for one month pending trial in FIR No.323 dated 18.09.2016 registered under Section 323, 324, 326, 307, 302 & 34 IPC and Section 27/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Kurukshetra University, District Kurukshetra.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the petition for grant of interim bail to the petitioner.

Indeed the petitioner is a main accused as contended by learned counsel for the complainant but then looking to the medical urgency, namely the surgery of his wife to be carried out on 30.10.2017, I think the concession of interim bail for a limited period of fifteen days is to be extended to the petitioner, particularly because on the earlier occasion there was no misconduct by him.

In that view of the matter, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-38346 OF 2017 is disposed of.
- (ii) The petitioner be released from the jail on interim bail for a period of fifteen days only, starting from the date of his release, subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
